#### PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:

The New and Mahoney Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP) (Atlantic Richfield Company, 2023) refers to engineered cap material as a 1.5-inch minus base course material. For end land use suitability concerns, an Agency-approved 3-inch minus material is being proposed (Attachment #1-2023 BPSOU Type B Borrow Submittal #1, dated November 13, 2023). As discussed during a site visit with Agency oversight personnel, the characteristics of the proposed 3-inch minus material suit the end land use of this area structurally better than the 1.5-inch minus base course. Additionally, there is a potential for undesired access to the Site via Curtis Street, New Street, and residential access routes. As a result, access controls are being evaluated and will be discussed with the property owner.

Additionally, the southern boundary of the site depicted in the final RAWP terminates at the Butte-Silver Bow right-of-way. Mobilization of field equipment and site remediation activities are anticipated to begin on November 27, 2023.

### PROPOSED MODIFICATION:

The 3-inch minus material is preferred over the 1.5-inch base course due to its superior structural characteristics and material availability. The 3-inch minus material is an Agency-approved material acquired from an Agency-approved source. Fully validated data will be included with the project construction completion report (CCR) provided for Agency review.

Access control measures will include landscape boulders acquired from an Agency-approved source. These boulders will mitigate traffic through the Site and improve the longevity of the proposed engineered cap.

The southern boundary of the site is proposed to extend to adjacent residential properties to provide a consistent engineered cap throughout the site and route storm water to the existing storm water inlet. The extended cap area will be graded to provide positive drainage away from the residential areas and toward the referenced storm water inlet.

Changes described herein will be implemented for scheduled Remedial Action construction of this Project. Additional sites may be identified to substitute of 1.5-inch base course for a 3-inch minus material, and these will be communicated to the Agencies prior to implementation. As-built drawings will reflect these changes prior to their submittal.
